- 2) **Incomplete application in any form will be summarily rejected. Non submission of Certificate / documents along with the application shall be liable for rejection.**
- 3) Candidates, who are already working in Health Department either on regular or on contractual basis, have to submit **No Objection Certificate** from concerned employer (appointing authority) at the time of interview, without which they will not be eligible for appearing interview. NOC issued by any other authority other than appointing authority will not be accepted. NOC must be specific for the post. S/He applying and must be issued subsequent to issue of the advertisement.
